

**TENDER FOR SUPPLY OF CUTLERY MACHINERY
TERMS & CONDITIONS**

PROJECT SITE:

G. T. Road, Wazirabad

FUNDED BY:

Competitiveness Support Fund
(A joint initiative of USAID and Government of Pakistan)

PROJECT PARTNERS:

Pak Cutlery Consortium [*A private sector cluster in Wazirabad for the production of Cutlery*] and Trade Development Authority of Pakistan [TDAP]

RIGHT TO BID:

The bidder has a right to submit bid for all or any item. Bid can only be submitted for supply of new machinery.

PRICE OF ITEM / CURRENCY:

Separate Prices should be quoted for each machinery item. Prices should include the amount of applicable import / custom duties and other taxes. Quotations are required to be submitted in Pak Rupees only.

PRICE FOR ACCESSORIES AND INSTALLATION:

Accessories required (*Other than those, considered as integral part of machinery*), which are essential for the working / operations of machinery, and their respective prices, should also be clearly mentioned in the bid / quotation.

Similarly, the price for installation (unless, if free) should also be clearly mentioned.

SPECIFICATIONS:

Provide detail specification [i.e. brand, capacity, etc] of each machinery item, for which the bid is being submitted. For imported machinery, mention the name of country, from which equipment will be imported.

Machines will be checked and verified, against quoted specification, before accepting the consignment.

WARRANTY:

Supplier is required to clearly mentioned the period and details of comprehensive warranty for all parts including their precision / accurate working. All items should be brand new.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED:

The suppliers are required to furnish the following additional information with bids / quotations:

- Warranty of machinery being supplied;
- Detail of relevant experience for manufacturing / supply of cutlery machinery;
- Technical resources (e.g. Equipment, Engineers, staff, etc);

- Evidence of registration with Income Tax / Sales Tax Department
- Any other related information

EVALUATION CRITERIA:

For the evaluation of bids / quotations, following criteria will apply:

- Technical specifications of machinery
- Price quoted for each item of machinery being supplied;
- Time period, required for delivery of equipment at project site;
- Relevant experience for manufacturing / supply of cutlery machinery;
- Warranty of machinery being supplied;
- Repair and maintenance services (after supply of cutlery machinery); and
- Technical resources of bidder (e.g. Equipment, Engineers, staff, etc)

CARRIAGE:

Supplier will be responsible to deliver the equipment at Project Site. Price (if any), to be charged for carriage, should be clearly mentioned in the bid / quotation.

INSTALLATION / FITTING:

Successful installation will include demonstrating, accurate / precision working, of cutlery machinery.

Price (if any), to be charged for installation, should be clearly mentioned in the bid / quotation. Any accessories required for installation and their prices should also be clearly mentioned in the bid / quotation.

PAYMENT TERMS:

Bid must include the desired payment terms and requirement for advance (if any) before the supply of equipment. Bidder should also provide the detail of security [i.e. bank guarantee, which will be provided to secure the advance payment]

BID MONEY:

Quotations must be accompanied with 2% call deposit (in the form of Pay Order / Demand Draft) in favor of Pak Cutlery Consortium.

BIDS VALIDITY:

Bids shall be valid for a period of six months. After, award of contract to successful bidder, the price mentioned in the contract, will remain valid, till the completion of contract.

DELIVERY TIME:

The time required for supply of each machinery items must clearly be mentioned in bids / quotation.

WITHHOLDING TAX:

The contract payments shall be subject to deduction of applicable withholding tax and any other taxes, as required under laws of Pakistan.

RIGHT TO REJECT ALL BIDS:

The Chairman, Pak Cutlery Consortium, has a right to reject all bids, at any time, prior to acceptance of bids.

TIME AND PLACE FOR SUBMISSION OF BIDS:

The bids should reach to the following address on or before May 28th, 2009 (12:30pm).
